

# Maker with Rame Parish Council

Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting

**held Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> December 2006**

**Open Forum:** i) Mr Gaskin requested the PCSO work after 10 pm to counter recent ASBs ii) Mr Gaskin informed that there was to be attempt to convert one of the fish cellars into a residence and felt this should be stopped

216. **Police Report:** PC Libby presented report for the last month (copy on file) and welcomed PCSO John Riggall. It was stated that the newly funded Outreach Youth Worker was working with early teenagers to early 20s. If changes to PCSO hours were required a letter to the Chief

Applicant: Mrs Glasspool, Millpool Cottage, 36 St Andrews Place

Development: Conversion of single storey extension to North elevation of dwelling to provide two residential units
